


Fortune 500 Women Executive Officers and Top Earners¹

2012 EXECUTIVE OFFICER POSITIONS



In 2011, women held 14.1 percent of Executive Officer positions.

2012 EXECUTIVE OFFICER TOP EARNER POSITIONS



In 2011, women held 7.5 percent of Executive Officer top earner positions.



COMPANIES BY PERCENTAGE OF EXECUTIVE OFFICER POSITIONS HELD BY WOMEN



In both 2011 and 2012, one-fifth of companies had 25 percent or more women Executive Officers, yet more than one-quarter had no women Executive Officers.
